# **Description**

The C library function **int putchar**intchar writes a character anunsignedchar specified by the argument char to stdout.

#### **Declaration**

Following is the declaration for putchar function.

```
int putchar(int char)
```

#### **Parameters**

• **char** -- This is the character to be written. This is passed as its int promotion.

### **Return Value**

This function returns the character written as an unsigned char cast to an int or EOF on error.

### **Example**

The following example shows the usage of putchar function.

```
#include <stdio.h>
int main ()
{
    char ch;
    for(ch = 'A' ; ch <= 'Z' ; ch++)
    {
        putchar(ch);
    }
    return(0);

```
