Description

The C library function **int putchar***intchar* writes a character *anunsignedchar* specified by the argument *char* to stdout.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for putchar function.

```
int putchar(int char)
```

Parameters

- **char** -- This is the character to be written. This is passed as its int promotion.

Return Value

This function returns the character written as an unsigned char cast to an int or EOF on error.

Example

The following example shows the usage of putchar function.

```
#include <stdio.h>

int main ()
{
    char ch;

    for(ch = 'A' ; ch <= 'Z' ; ch++)
    {
        putchar(ch);
    }

    return(0);
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program that will produce the following result:

```
ABCDEFGHIJKLMMNOPQRSTUVWXYZ
```
