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Description

It going to provide the light or lighting with speed to element

Syntax

```
@keyframes lightSpeedOut {
  0% {
    transform: translateX(0%) skewX(0deg);
    opacity: 1;
  }
  100% {
    transform: translateX(100%) skewX(-30deg);
    opacity: 0;
  }
}
```

Parameters

- **Transform** – Transform applies to 2d and 3d transformation to an element
- **Opacity** – Opacity applies to an element to make translucence

        animation-name: lightSpeedOut;
        -webkit-animation-timing-function: ease-in;
        animation-timing-function: ease-in;

    .animated.lightSpeedOut {
        -webkit-animation-duration: 0.25s;
        animation-duration: 0.25s;
    }
