

# CSS - BORDER-TOP-COLOR

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## Description

Sets the color of an element's top border; default is the color of the element.

## Possible Values

- **color** – Any valid color value.

## Applies to

All the HTML elements.

## DOM Syntax

```
object.style.borderTopColor = "red";
```

## Example

Here is the example which shows effect of this property –

    border:1px solid;
    border-bottom-color:#009900; /* Green */
    border-top-color:#FF0000;    /* Red */
    border-left-color:#330000;   /* Black */
    border-right-color:#0000CC;  /* Blue */
