

Description

The *caption-side* property determines the placement of the element box of a table's caption.

Possible Values

- **top** – Places the caption's element box above the table box.
- **bottom** – Places the caption's element box below the table box.
- **left** – Places the caption's element box to the left of the table box.
- **right** – Places the caption's element box to the right of the table box.

Applies to

All the HTML positioned element.

DOM Syntax

```
object.style.captionSide = "left";
```
