

Description

The *color* property sets the foreground color of an element *typically, the color of the text*.

Possible Values

- **color** – should be any valid color value.

Applies to

All the HTML elements.

DOM Syntax

```
object.style.color = "#a1a1a1";
```

Example

Here is the example which shows effect of this property –

```
<html>
<head>
</head>
<body>
  <h2 style="color:olive;">
    This text will have olive color.
  </h2>

  <p style="color:#3300CC">
    This text will have blue color.
  </p>

  <div style="color:rgb(224,37,197);">
    This text will have pink color.
  </div>
</body>
</html>
```

This will produce following result –



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
