

Description

The *direction* indicates the writing direction to be used in the rendering of an element.

Possible Values

- **ltr** – element will be rendered from left to right.
- **rtl** – element will be rendered from right to left.

Applies to

All the HTML elements.

DOM Syntax

```
object.style.direction = "ltr";
```

Example

Here is the example –

```
<html>
<head>
</head>
<body>
  <p style="direction:rtl;">
    Right-to-left rendering direction - Example
  </p>

  <p style="direction:ltr;">
    Left-to-right rendering direction - Example
  </p>
</body>
</html>
```
