Description

The *font-size-adjust* property is used to improve the legibility of alternate font choices.

Possible Values

- **number** – The aspect value of the first font listed in the value of the property font-family. This value is used in the equation $fs \times fa/aa = as$, where fs is the declared value of font-size for the element, fa is the declared value of font-size-adjust, aa is the aspect value of the actual font to be used, and as is the computed font-size for the element.
- **none** – No size adjustments should be made to alternate font choices.

Applies to

All the HTML elements.

DOM Syntax

```
object.style.fontSizeAdjust = "0.61";
```

Example

Here is the example using this property –
