

Description

The *margin-top* property sets the width of the margin on the top of an element.

Possible Values

- **length** – Any length value.
- **percentage** – The margin's width is calculated with respect to the width of the element's containing block.
- **auto** – Default, Let the browsers automatically set the margin.

Applies to

All the HTML elements.

DOM Syntax

```
object.style.marginTop = "5px"
```

Example

Here is the example –

  <body>
    <p style="margin-top: 15px; border:1px solid black;">
      This is a paragraph with a specified top margin
    </p>

    <p style="margin-top: 5%; border:1px solid black;">
      This is another paragraph with a specified top margin in percent
    </p>

</html>
```
