# **Description**

The max-width property is used to set an upper bound on the width of an element.

#### **Possible Values**

- length Any length unit. The element can never have a value for width which exceeds this
  distance.
- **percentage** Limits the element's width to be at most this percentage of the width of the containing block.
- **none** There is no limit to the width of the element.

### **Applies to**

All the HTML elements except non-replaced inline elements and table elements.
