

Description

The *outline-color* property sets the color for an outline around an element.

Possible Values

- **color** – Any valid color value.
- **invert** – The outline performs a color inversion of the area where it is drawn.

Applies to

All the HTML elements.

DOM Syntax

```
object.style.outlineColor = "red";
```
