

CSS - PAUSE-AFTER

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Description

The *pause-after* property defines the duration of a silent pause to be inserted after the content of an element.

Possible Values

- **time** – Any time value *e. g.* , *300ms*; the pause will be the length of time specified.
- **percentage** – The length of the pause is dictated by the value of speech-rate. Thus, *pause-after: 33%* would yield *167ms* if the speech rate is two words per second *120wordsperminute*, and *333ms* if it's one word per second *60wordsperminute*.

DOM Syntax

object.style.pauseAfter = "300ms";
```
