## **Description**

The *pause* is a shorthand element for pause-before and pause-after.

### **Possible Values**

- **time** Any time value *e. g.*, 150*ms*; the pause will be the length of time specified.
- percentage The length of the pause is dictated by the value of speech-rate. For a speechrate of 60 words per minute, which corresponds to one word per second, then a percentage is calculated with respect to one second. For a speech-rate of 120 words per minute, which yields a time per word of 500 milliseconds, then percentage would be calculated with respect to 500 milliseconds.
