# CSS - PSEUDO-CLASS :VISITED

## **Description**

The :visited pseudo-class is used to add special effect to a visited link.

While defining pseudo-classes in a <style>...</style> block, following points should be taken care:

- a:hover MUST come after a:link and a:visited in the CSS definition in order to be effective.
- a:active MUST come after a:hover in the CSS definition in order to be effective.
- Pseudo-class names are not case-sensitive.
- Pseudo-class are different from CSS classes but they can be combined.

#### **Possible Values**

• **color** – Any valid color value.

## **Applies to**

Anchor / Link element.

### **Example**

Following is the example which demonstrates how to use :link class to set the link color.

This will produce following black link -
