| Property                      | Description   |
|-------------------------------|---|
| <a href="#">:active</a>       | Use this class to add special effect to an activated element.                                     |
| <a href="#">:focus</a>        | Use this class to add special effect to an element while the element has focus.                   |
| <a href="#">:hover</a>        | Use this class to add special effect to an element when you mouse over it.                        |
| <a href="#">:link</a>         | Use this class to add special effect to an unvisited link.  |
| <a href="#">:visited</a>      | Use this class to add special effect to a visited link.   |
| <a href="#">:first-child</a>  | Use this class to add special effect to an element that is the first child of some other element. |
| <a href="#">:lang</a>         | Use this class to specify a language to use in a specified element.                               |
| <a href="#">:first-letter</a> | Use this element to add special effect to the first letter of a text.                             |
| <a href="#">:first-line</a>   | Use this element to add special effect to the first line of a text.                               |
| <a href="#">:before</a>       | Use this element to insert some content before an element.  |
| <a href="#">:after</a>        | Use this element to insert some content after an element.   |
