Click any property to see its description with examples –

Property	Description
<a href="#">color</a>	Sets the color of an element.
<a href="#">direction</a>	Defines direction of the flow of an element content.
<a href="#">line-height</a>	Sets the distance between adjacent text baselines.
<a href="#">text-align</a>	Sets the text alignment style for an element.
<a href="#">text-decoration</a>	Defines any decoration for the text; values may be combined.
<a href="#">text-indent</a>	Defines the indentation of the first line of text in an element; default is 0.
<a href="#">text-shadow</a>	Creates text drop shadows of varying colors and offsets.
<a href="#">text-transform</a>	Transforms the text in the element accordingly.
<a href="#">vertical-align</a>	Sets the vertical positioning of an element.
<a href="#">white-space</a>	Defines how whitespace within an element is handled.
<a href="#">word-spacing</a>	Inserts additional space between words.
