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Description

The HTML <hr> tag is used for creating a horizontal line. This is also called Horizontal Rule in HTML.

Example

```
<!DOCTYPE html>
<html>
<head>
<title>HTML hr Tag</title>
</head>
<body>
<p>This text will be followed by a horizontal line <hr /></p>
</body>
</html>
```

Specific Attributes

The HTML <hr> tag also supports following additional attributes:

Attribute	Value	Description
align	left right center	<i>Deprecated</i> -Specifies the alignment of the horizontal rule.
noshade	noshade	<i>Deprecated</i> -Removes the usual shading effect that most browsers display.
size	pixels or %	<i>Deprecated</i> -Specifies the height of the horizontal rule.
width	pixels or %	<i>Deprecated</i> -Specifies the width of the horizontal rule.
