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Description

The HTML <param> tag is used for passing parameters to an embedded object using <object> tag.

Example

You can specify some parameters related to the document with the tag. Here is an example to embed a wav file:

```
<!DOCTYPE html>
<html>
<head>
<title>HTML param Tag</title>
</head>
<body>
<object title="Test Object." class>
  <param name="audio" value="music.wav" />
  <param name="width" value="600" />
  <param name="height" value="400" />
</object>
</body>
</html>
```

Attribute	Value	Description
name	parameter type	Defines a unique name for the parameter.
type	MIME type	Specifies the internet media type for the parameter.
value	value	Specifies the value of the parameter.
valuetype	data refobject	Specifies the MIME type of the value.
