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Description

The HTML <tr> tag is used for specifying a table row within a table.

Example

Attribute	Value	Description
align	right left center justify	<i>Deprecated</i> -Visual alignment.

	char	
bgcolor	rgbx, x, x #hexcode colorname	<i>Deprecated</i> -Specifies the background color of the table cell.
char	character	<i>Deprecated</i> -Specifies which character to align text on. Used when align="char".
charoff	pixels or %	<i>Deprecated</i> -Specifies an alignment offset <i>either in pixels or percentage value</i> against the first character as specified with the char attribute. Used when align="char".
valign	top middle bottom baseline	<i>Deprecated</i> -Vertical alignment.
