

JAVA.LANG.BOOLEAN.BOOLEANVALUE METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.Boolean.booleanValue** returns the value of this Boolean object as a boolean primitive.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Boolean.booleanValue** method

```
public boolean booleanValue()
```

Parameters

Return Value

This method returns the primitive boolean value of this object.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of lang.Boolean.booleanValue method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class BooleanDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a Boolean object b
        Boolean b;

        // assign value to b
        b = new Boolean(true);

        // create a boolean primitive type bool
        boolean bool;

        // assign primitive value of b to bool
        bool = b.booleanValue();

        String str = "Primitive value of Boolean object " + b + " is " + bool;

        // print bool value
        System.out.println( str );

    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Primitive value of Boolean object true is true
```

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
