

JAVA.LANG.BYTE.TOSTRING METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.Byte.toString** *byteb* returns a new String object representing the specified byte. The radix is assumed to be 10.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Byte.toString** method

```
public static String toString(byte b)
```

Parameters

- **b** - the byte to be converted

Return Value

This method returns the string representation of the specified byte.

Exception

- NA

Example

The following example shows the usage of lang.Byte.toString method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class ByteDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a byte primitive bt and assign value
        byte bt = 20;

        // create a String s
        String s;

        /**
         * static method is called using class name. Assign
         * string representation of bt to s
         */
        s = Byte.toString(bt);

        String str = "String representation of byte primitive " +bt+ " is " +s;

        // print s value
        System.out.println( str );
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
String representation of byte primitive 20 is 20
```

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
