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Description

The **java.lang.Character.charValue** returns the value of this Character object.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Character.charValue** method

```
public char charValue()
```

Parameters

Return Value

This method returns the primitive char value represented by this object.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of lang.Character.charValue method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class CharacterDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a Character object c
        Character c;

        // assign value to c
        c = new Character('a');

        // create a char primitive ch
        char ch;

        // assign primitive value of c to ch
        ch = c.charValue();

        String str = "Primitive char value is " + ch;

        // print ch value
        System.out.println( str );

    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Primitive char value is a
```

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
