The **java.lang.Compiler.disable** method cause the Compiler to cease operation.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Compiler.disable** method

```
public static void disable()
```

Parameters

Return Value

This method does not return any value.

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.Compiler.disable method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class CompilerDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // checking if compiler is enabled or not
        Compiler.enable();
        System.out.println("Compiler Enabled...");
        Compiler.command("{java.lang.Integer.*}(compile)");

        Integer i = new Integer("30");

        // returns a hash code value
        int retval = i.hashCode();
        System.out.println("Value = " + retval);

        // disable the compiler
        System.out.println("Disabling Compiler...");
        Compiler.disable();
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Compiler Enabled...
Value = 30
Disabling Compiler...
```

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
