

JAVA.LANG.DOUBLE.BYTEVALUE METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.Double.byteValue** method returns the value of this Double as a byte *broadcasting to a byte*.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Double.byteValue** method

```
public byte byteValue()
```

Parameters

Return Value

This method returns the double value represented by this object converted to type byte.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.Double.byteValue method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class DoubleDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        /* returns the double value represented by this object converted
        to type byte */
        Double obj = new Double("20");
        byte b = obj.byteValue();
        System.out.println("Value = " + b);

        obj = new Double("30.95");
        b = obj.byteValue();
        System.out.println("Value = " + b);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Value = 20
Value = 30
```

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
