

JAVA.LANG.DOUBLE.TOSTRINGDOUBLED METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.Double.toStringdoubled** method returns a string representation of the double argument. The argument **d** is the double value to be converted.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Double.toString** method

```
public static String toString(double d)
```

Parameters

- **d** -- This is the double to be converted.

Return Value

This method returns a String representation of the argument.

Exception

- **NA**

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.Double.toString method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class DoubleDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        Double d1 = new Double("9.7");

        // returns a string representation of the double argument
        String retval = Double.toString(d1);
        System.out.println("Value = " + retval);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Value = 9.7
```

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
