Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Float.hashCode** method

```
public int hashCode()
```

This method returns a hash code value for this object.

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.Float.hashCode method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class FloatDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        Float f = new Float("25.57f");

        // returns a hash code value
        int retval = f.hashCode();
        System.out.println("Value = " + retval);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Value = 1103925084
```

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
