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Description

The **java.lang.Float.toStringfloatf** method returns a string representation of the float argument **f**.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Float.toString** method

```
public static String toString(float f)
```

Parameters

- **f** -- This is the float to be converted.

Return Value

This method returns a string representation of the argument.

Exception

- **NA**

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.Float.toString method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class FloatDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        Float f = new Float("32.74");

        // returns a string representation of the float argument
        String retval = Float.toString(f);
        System.out.println("Value = " + retval);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Value = 32.74
```

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
