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Description

The **java.lang.Integer.floatValue** method returns the value of this Integer as a float.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Integer.floatValue** method

```
public float floatValue()
```

Parameters

Return Value

This method returns the numeric value represented by this object after conversion to type float.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.Integer.floatValue method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class IntegerDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        Integer obj = new Integer(35);

        // returns the value of this Integer as a float
        float f = obj.floatValue();
        System.out.println("Value of f = " + f);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Value of f = 35.0
```

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
