

# JAVA.LANG.INTEGER.INTVALUE METHOD

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## Description

The **java.lang.Integer.intValue** method returns the value of this Integer as an int.

## Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Integer.intValue** method

```
public int intValue()
```

## Parameters

## Return Value

This method returns the numeric value represented by this object after conversion to type int.

## Exception

## Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.Integer.intValue method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class IntegerDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        Integer obj = new Integer(15);

        // returns the value of this Integer as an int
        int i = obj.intValue();
        System.out.println("Value of i = " + i);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Value of i = 15
```

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
