

JAVA.LANG.INTEGER.TOSTRING(*int*) METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.Integer.toString(*int*)** method returns a String object representing the specified integer.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Integer.toString** method

```
public static String toString(int i)
```

Parameters

- **i** -- This is an integer to be converted.

Return Value

This method returns a string representation of the argument in base 10.

Exception

- **NA**

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.Integer.toString method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class IntegerDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        Integer i = new Integer(10);

        // returns a string representation of the specified integer in base 10
        String retval = i.toString(30);
        System.out.println("Value = " + retval);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Value = 30
```

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
