

JAVA.LANG.LONG.TOHEXSTRING METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.Long.toHexString** method returns a string representation of the long argument as an unsigned integer in base 16. The following characters are used as hexadecimal digits:
0123456789abcdef

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Long.toHexString** method

```
public static String toHexString(long i)
```

Parameters

- **i** -- This is the long to be converted to a string.

Return Value

This method returns the string representation of the unsigned long value represented by the argument in hexadecimal *base16*.

Exception

- **NA**

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.Long.toHexString method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class LongDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        long l = 220;
        System.out.println("Number = " + l);

        /* returns the string representation of the unsigned long value
        represented by the argument in hexadecimal (base 16) */
        System.out.println("Hex = " + Long.toHexString(l));
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Number = 220
Hex = dc
```

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
