

JAVA.LANG.SHORT.TOSTRING METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.Short.toString** method returns a String object representing this Short value. The value is converted to signed decimal representation and returned as a string

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Short.toString** method

```
public String toString()
```

Parameters

This method returns a string representation of the value of this object in base 10.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.Short.toString method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class ShortDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create short object and assign value to it
        short sval = 50;
        Short shortValue = new Short(sval);

        // returns a String object representing this Short value.
        System.out.println("Value is = " + shortValue.toString());
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Value is = 50
```
