

JAVA.LANG.SHORT.VALUEOF*SHORTS* METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.Short.valueOf*shorts*** method returns a Short instance representing the specified **short** value.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.Short.valueOf** method

```
public static Short valueOf(short s)
```

Parameters

- **s** -- This is the short value.

Return Value

This method returns a Short instance representing s.

Exception

- **NA**

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.Short.valueOf method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class ShortDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        short shortNum = 100;

        // returns Short instance representing given short value
        Short ShortValue = Short.valueOf(shortNum);

        // displays the short object value
        System.out.println("Short object representing the specified short
value = " + ShortValue);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Short object representing the specified short value = 100
```

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
