

JAVA.LANG.STRING.CONCAT METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.String.concat** method concatenates the specified string to the end of this string.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.String.concat** method

```
public String concat(String str)
```

Parameters

- **str** -- This is the String that is concatenated to the end of this String.

Return Value

This method returns a string that represents the concatenation of this object's characters followed by the string argument's characters.

Exception

- **NA**

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.String.concat method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class StringDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // print str1
        String str1 = "self";
        System.out.println(str1);

        // print str2 concatenated with str1
        String str2 = str1.concat(" learning");
        System.out.println(str2);

        // prints str3 concatenated with str2(and str1)
        String str3 = str2.concat(" center");
        System.out.println(str3);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
self
self learning
self learning center
```

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
