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Description

The **java.lang.String.copyValueOf(char[] data)** method returns a String that represents the character sequence in the array specified.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.String.copyValueOf** method

```
public static String copyValueOf(char[] data)
```

Parameters

- **data** -- This is the character array.

Return Value

This method returns a String that contains the characters of the character array.

Exception

- NA

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.String.copyValueOf method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class StringDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // character array
        char[] charArr = { 'J', 'A', 'V', 'A' };

        // returns a String that contains the characters of the character array
        String str = String.copyValueOf(charArr);

        // prints the string
        System.out.println(str);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
.JAVA
```
