

# JAVA.LANG.STRING.ISEMPTY METHOD

## Description

The **java.lang.String.isEmpty** method returns true only if length is 0.

## Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.String.isEmpty** method

```
public boolean isEmpty()
```

## Parameters

- NA

## Return Value

This method returns true if length is 0, else false.

## Exception

- NA

## Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.String.isEmpty method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;  
  
import java.lang.*;  
  
public class StringDemo {  
  
    public static void main(String[] args) {  
  
        String str = "tutorialspoint";  
  
        // prints length of string  
        System.out.println("length of string = " + str.length());  
  
        // checks if the string is empty or not  
        System.out.println("is this string empty? = " + str.isEmpty());  
    }  
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
length of string = 14  
is this string empty? = false
