

JAVA.LANG.STRING.REPLACE METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.String.replace***charoldChar, charnewChar* method returns a new string resulting from replacing all occurrences of **oldChar** in this string with **newChar**.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.String.replace** method

```
public String replace(char oldChar, char newChar)
```

Parameters

- **oldChar** -- This is the old character.
- **newChar** -- This is the new character.

Return Value

This method returns a string derived from this string by replacing every occurrence of oldChar with newChar.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.String.replace method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class StringDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        String str = "aacdeaa";
        System.out.println("string = " + str);

        // replace all 'a' characters with 'b' characters.
        String replaceStr = str.replace('a', 'b');

        // prints the strings after replacement
        System.out.println("new string = " + replaceStr);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
string = aacdeaa
new string = bbcdebb
```

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
