

JAVA.LANG.STRING.TRIM METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.String.trim** method returns a copy of the string and omits leading and trailing whitespace.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.String.trim** method

```
public String trim()
```

Parameters

- NA

Return Value

This method returns a copy of this string with leading and trailing white space removed, or this string if it has no leading or trailing white space.

Exception

- NA

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.String.trim method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class StringDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // string with leading and trailing white space
        String str = " This is Tutorialspoint ";

        System.out.print("Before trim = ");
        System.out.println(".." + str + "..");

        // leading and trailing white space removed
        System.out.print("After trim = ");
        System.out.println(".." + str.trim() + "..");
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Before trim = .. This is Tutorialspoint ..
After trim = .. This is Tutorialspoint..
```

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
