

JAVA.LANG.STRING.VALUEOF METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.String.valueOfObjectobj** method returns the string representation of the **Object** argument.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.String.valueOf** method

```
public static String valueOf(Object obj)
```

Parameters

- **obj** -- This is an object.

Return Value

If the argument is null, then a string equal to "null", else the value of obj.toString is returned.

Exception

- NA

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.String.valueOf method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class StringDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        String str = "compile online";
        Object objVal = str;

        // returns the string representation of the Object argument
        System.out.println("Value = " + str.valueOf(objVal));
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Value = compile online
```
