

JAVA.LANG.STRINGBUFFER.LENGTH METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.StringBuffer.length** method returns the length *charactercount* of the sequence of characters currently represented by this object.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.StringBuffer.length** method

```
public int length()
```

Parameters

Return Value

This method returns the length of the sequence of characters currently represented by this object.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.StringBuffer.length method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;

public class StringBufferDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        StringBuffer buff = new StringBuffer("Tutorials");
        // printing the length of stringbuffer
        System.out.println("length = " + buff.length());

        buff = new StringBuffer("");
        // printing the length of empty stringbuffer
        System.out.println("length = " + buff.length());
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
length = 9
length = 0
```

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
