

JAVA.LANG.SYSTEM.CONSOLE METHOD

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Description

The **java.lang.System.console** method returns the unique Console object associated with the current Java virtual machine, if any.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.lang.System.console** method

```
public static Console console()
```

Parameters

Return Value

This method returns the system console, if any, otherwise null.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.lang.System.console method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.lang.*;
import java.io.Console;

public class SystemDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        Console ob = System.console();

        ob.printf("Welcome to tutorialspoint...");

        // flushes the console
        ob.flush();
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Welcome to tutorialspoint...
```
