

JAVA.MATH.BIGDECIMAL.VALUEOF METHOD

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Description

The **java.math.BigDecimal.valueOf** translates a long value into a BigDecimal with a scale of zero. This "static factory method" is provided in preference to a *long* constructor because it allows for reuse of frequently used BigDecimal values.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.math.BigDecimal.valueOf** method

```
public static BigDecimal valueOf(long val)
```

Parameters

- **val** - value of the BigDecimal

Return Value

This method returns a BigDecimal whose value is val.

Exception

- NA

Example

The following example shows the usage of **math.BigDecimal.valueOf** method

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.math.*;

public class BigDecimalDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a BigDecimal object
        BigDecimal bg;

        // create a Long Object
        Long l = new Long("12345678");

        // assign the bigdecimal value of l to bg
        // static method is called using class name
        bg = BigDecimal.valueOf(l);

        String str = "The Long After Conversion to BigDecimal is " + bg;

        // print bg value
        System.out.println( str );

    }

}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
The Long After Conversion to BigDecimal is 12345678
```
