Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.ArrayDeque.size** method

```
public int size()
```

This method returns the number of elements in this deque.

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.ArrayDeque.size method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.ArrayDeque;
import java.util.Deque;

public class ArrayDequeDemo {
    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create an empty array deque with an initial capacity
        Deque<Integer> deque = new ArrayDeque<Integer>(8);

        // use add() method to add elements in the deque
        deque.add(15);
        deque.add(20);
        deque.add(25);
        deque.add(22);

        // let us print all the elements available in deque
        for (Integer number : deque) {
            System.out.println("Number = " + number);
        }

        // this will print the size of this deque
        int retval = deque.size();
        System.out.println("Size of deque = " + retval);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Number = 15
Number = 20
Number = 25
Number = 22
```

Size of deque = 4

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
