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Description

The **java.util.Calendar.clone** returns a shallow copy of this Calendar object.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.Calendar.clone** method

```
public Object clone()
```

Parameters

Return Value

This method does not return any value.

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.Calendar.clone method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class CalendarDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create new calendar at specific date.
        Calendar cal = new GregorianCalendar(2008, 05, 20);

        // print date for default value
        System.out.println("Past calendar : " + cal.getTime());

        // create a clone of first cal
        Calendar cal2 = (Calendar) cal.clone();

        // display the copy
        System.out.println("Cloned calendar : " + cal2.getTime());
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Past calendar : Fri Jun 20 00:00:00 EEST 2008
Cloned calendar : Fri Jun 20 00:00:00 EEST 2008
```

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
