public static Calendar getInstance()
```

The following example shows the usage of java.util.Calendar.getInstance method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class CalendarDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a calendar
        Calendar cal = Calendar.getInstance();

        // gets a calendar using the default time zone and locale.
        System.out.print("Date And Time Is: " + cal.getTime());
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

Date And Time Is: Tue May 01 18:53:09 EEST 2012
