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Description

The **java.util.Calendar.getLeastMaximum** method returns the lowest maximum value for the given calendar **field** of this Calendar instance.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.Calendar.getLeastMaximum** method

```
public abstract int getLeastMaximum()(field)
```

Parameters

- **field** -- the given calendar field.

Return Value

Returns lowest maximum value of the given calendar field.

Exception

- NA

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.calendar.getLeastMaximum method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class CalendarDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a calendar
        Calendar cal = Calendar.getInstance();

        // get the days required in the first week of the year
        System.out.println("Months required: " + cal.get(Calendar.MONTH));

        // print the lowest maximum months for year.
        int max = cal.getLeastMaximum(Calendar.MONTH);
        System.out.println("Lowest maximum months :"+ max);

    }

}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Months required: 4
Lowest maximum months :11
```

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
