

JAVA.UTIL.CALENDAR.SETLENIENT METHOD

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Description

The **java.util.Calendar.setLenient***boolean* method specifies whether date/time interpretation is to be lenient or not.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.Calendar.setLenient** method

```
public void setLenient(boolean lenient)
```

Parameters

- **lenient** -- true if the lenient mode is to be turned on; false if it is to be turned off.

Return Value

This method does not return a value.

Exception

- NA

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.calendar.setLenient method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class CalendarDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a calendar
        Calendar cal = Calendar.getInstance();

        // print current state of lenient
        boolean b = cal.isLenient();
        System.out.println("Calendar is lenient : " + b);

        // change lenient state
        cal.setLenient(false);

        // print result
        System.out.println("Lenient after setting : " + cal.isLenient());

    }

}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Calendar is lenient :true
Lenient after setting :false
```

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
