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Description

The **java.util.Calendar.setMinimalDaysInFirstWeek***int* method sets how many minimal days required in the first week of the year.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.Calendar.setMinimalDaysInFirstWeek** method

```
public void setMinimalDaysInFirstWeek(int value)
```

Parameters

- **value** -- the given minimal days required in the first week of the year.

Return Value

This method does not return a value.

Exception

- NA

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.calendar.setMinimalDaysInFirstWeek method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class CalendarDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a calendar
        Calendar cal = Calendar.getInstance();

        // get what is the minimal days required in the first week
        int min = cal.getMinimalDaysInFirstWeek();
        System.out.println("Minimal Days in Week: " + min);

        // set the minimal days required in the first week
        cal.setMinimalDaysInFirstWeek(2);

        // print the result
        min = cal.getMinimalDaysInFirstWeek();
        System.out.println("Minimal Days in Week: " + min);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Minimal Days in Week: 1
Minimal Days in Week: 2
```

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
