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Description

The **java.util.Currency.getSymbol** method returns the symbol of this currency for the default locale.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.Currency.getSymbol** method

```
public String getSymbol()
```

This method returns currency's symbol for the default locale.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.Currency.getSymbol method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class CurrencyDemo {

    public static void main(String args[]) {

        // create a currency for euro
        Currency curr = Currency.getInstance("EUR");

        // get and print the symbol of the currency
        String symbol = curr.getSymbol();
        System.out.println("Currency symbol is = " + symbol);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Currency symbol is = €
```
