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Description

The **java.util.Dictionary.isEmpty** method check if this dictionary has no keys to value.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.Dictionary.isEmpty** method

```
public abstract boolean isEmpty()
```

Parameters

Return Value

This method returns true if this dictionary has no keys to values; false otherwise.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.Dictionary.isEmpty method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class DictionaryDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a new hashtable
        Dictionary d = new Hashtable();

        // add elements in the hashtable
        d.put("1", "Chocolate");
        d.put("2", "Cocoa");
        d.put("5", "Coffee");

        // return true if this dictionary maps no keys to value.
        boolean b = d.isEmpty();
        System.out.println("Dictionary is empty:" + b);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Dictionary is empty:false
```

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
